i. **History of the Institution**

Gangadharpur Sikshan Mandir, a teachers' training College is situated at Gangadharpur village under Panchla Police Station of Howrah district of West Bengal. It was established in 2005 by the legend Sri Santosh Kumar Das, an educationalist, social worker and founder-secretary of Keshab-Uma-Charitable Trust (KUCT) under which the college runs. The college was accorded due recognition by the NCTE (ER) in 2005 and was affiliated to C.U. to conduct B.Ed. course with 100 intake capacity. Subsequently in the year 2009. The college got recognition /permission to conduct D.El.Ed. Course with 50 intake and also it got permission for M.Ed. course with 35 intake capacity which has now been raised to 50. The D.El.Ed. section of the college is affiliated to W.B.B.P.E. The B.Ed. and the M.Ed. sections of the college were first affiliated to Calcutta University. But now the affiliating body of these sections (B.Ed. & M.Ed.) is West Bengal University of Teachers' Training Education Planning and Administration (WBUTTEPA). The college is now a Composite Teachers' Training Institution with three programmers – B.Ed., D.El.Ed. and M.Ed. and is conducting the said courses satisfactorily with excellent result.
